KQED, KTVU, and the *San Francisco Chronicle* sponsor first debate between Senate candidates Boxer and Fiorina

What: [KQED](#), KTVU, and the *San Francisco Chronicle* will host the first debate between Democratic Sen. Barbara Boxer and Republican Carly Fiorina on Wednesday, September 1 at 7pm. The one-hour debate will air live on KQED Public Radio and KTVU Channel 2 (FOX).
