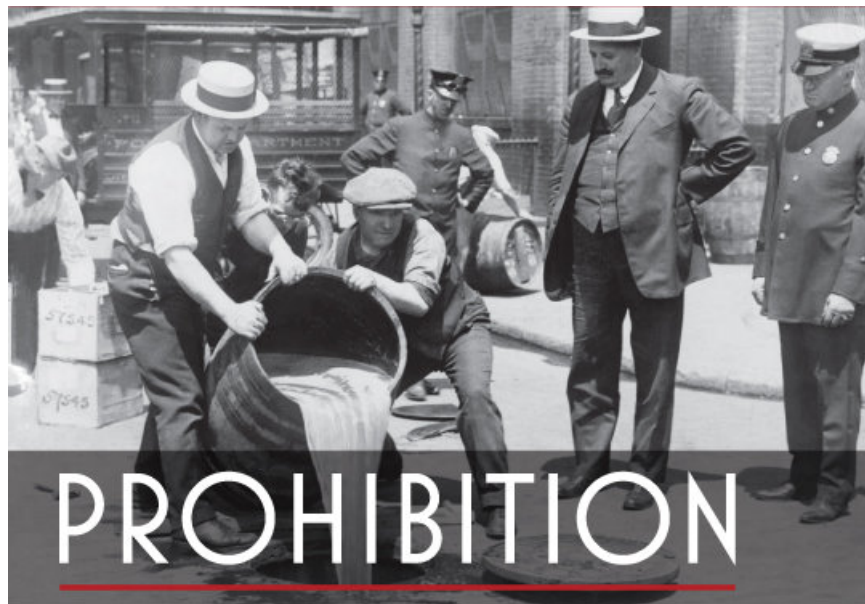

KQED hosts an Educators' Workshop with filmmakers Ken Burns and Lynn Novick
